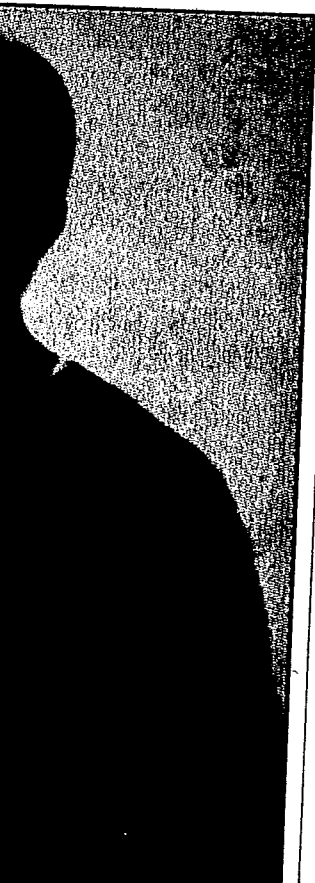

JPI makes offer for Olympus proposal

Developer gives up concessions in attempt to gain Council approval

A Texas developer made its
best and final offer to the City
Council last night, offering sev-
eral concessions as it tries to get
council approval before time
runs out at the end of the year.

Speaking before the Ordi-
nances & Rules Committee, JPI
presented a plan for developing
the former Olympus Hospital
site off Trapelo Road with 268
units, 44 percent of which
would be for people over age 55

and 10 percent of which would
be "affordable." All of them will
be for sale.

Two weeks ago, councilors
outlined for JPI their "three de-
sires" - fewer units, a higher
percentage of units for sale
rather than for rent, and a high-
er percentage of affordable
units.

night praised JPI for improving
its proposal and bringing it even
further from its original plan of
