Before last night, JPI's
standing offer was for 290
units, some of
which were
to be rentals.

Still, com-
mittee mem-
bers did not
appear ready
last night to
make a posi-
tive recom-
mendation to
the full coun-
cil. Late last
night, discus-
sion seemed to indicate
that the committee would
hold a special meeting
Thursday to review and
vote on a final draft.

Even with the commit-
tee's stamp of approval,
the request for a special

permit would still have to
go before the full council,
which would likely happen
next Monday.

If the request is not ap-
proved by the end of the
year, JPI
