Smaller JPI plan advances

Rules Committee recommends OK for
268-unit development on Trapelo Road

WALTHAM — After seven months of intense negotiations, a housing development proposed for the former Olympus Hospital site emerged from a powerful City Council committee last night with a recommendation for approval.

The Ordinance & Rules Committee unanimously recommended that the full council approve the special permit request

for 268 units at 775 Trapelo Road. The development would be known as Jefferson at Waltham.

The request will likely go before the full council Monday night where it must receive at least 10 of the 15 councilors' votes.
