## City may raise fees for outside sewer hookups

WALTHAM – Earlier this month, the developer of a subdivision in Lexington asked to tie in to the city's sewer system. The request was met with a tepid response from the City Council.

Some councilors asked how Waltham would benefit from the link. A representative for the developer said one advantage would be that the city would get roughly \$100,000 for the removal of stormwater and groundwater from the city's sewer system

On Tuesday, Ward S Councilor Stephen Rourke said that developers with properties outside the city need to pay more if they want to connect to the Waltham's sewer system

He pitched a resolution that asks the council to amend the city's ordinance to add higher "classifications and fees" for applicants whose properties lie outside the city's boundaries

"In terms of a ratio, I'm looking at it being three times whatever the cost would be to a property owner inside the city," Rourke said vesterday

Rourke's resolution will be heard by the Public Works Committee, which will hold its next meeting Monday. The committee could also consider the request from Lexington August Realty Trust at that meeting.

Rourke said in his resolution that the city has spent a lot of money to upgrade its sewer system and that developments in neighboring communities add to the **SEWER,** Page AS
